



Question number	Possible marks	Solution
1	14	 a. Stamen b. Pistil c. Petal d. Sepal e. Leaf f. Stem g. Root
2	21	 a. No pollen produced, no seeds made, no new plants. b. No ovules produced, no seeds, no new plants. c. Plant cannot attract insects/birds/pollinators, no pollination, no new plants. d. No protection of bud/flower. e. No photosynthesis, no food for plant, plant dies. f. No support above ground, plant not get enough sunlight, plant dies. g. No uptake of water and minerals, plant will die.
3	9	Water, light, carbon dioxide – for photosynthesis. Assess paragraphs in terms of how the learners describe the needs of the plant as being met by the environment.
