### **Assessment Task: Planet Earth**

		Atmosphere: Gaseous nitrogen, oxygen, carbon dioxide and water
		vapour predominate.
		Three features that make it unique among the planets: Liquid water,
		supports life, stable temperatures over most of planet, etc.
		Five other interesting facts: Facts will vary.
