

# **Grade 9 Mathematics Worksheet**

### **Factorization**

### **Questions:**

1. 
$$\frac{65^2 - 25^2}{65 + 25} = \dots$$

- A) 90
- B) 17,8
- C) 50
- D)  $\frac{4}{9}$



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#### Solution

1. 
$$\frac{65^2 - 25^2}{65 + 25} = \frac{(65 - 15)(65 + 25)}{65 + 25} = 65 - 25 = 40$$

In feedback to learners it is important to note that in *the quotient you may not cancel over any term*. This is the classic mistake that happens in this type of problem.
