OC: Metal Machinist (Turner)	A metal machinist is a skilled tradesperson who specializes in working with metals to create precision parts and instruments. They operate and maintain various machinery, such as lathes, milling machines, grinders, and advanced computer numerical control (CNC) equipment
OC: Toolmaker	A toolmaker is a highly skilled engineer who specializes in creating precision tools, dies, molds, jigs, and fixtures used in manufacturing processes. They work with various materials, including metals and specialized alloys, to produce tools that help manufacture parts or products efficiently.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- NQF Level 4 (Grade 12) with Maths and Science, or
- N2-6 with 4 subjects and relevant trade theory included, or

- NCV Level 3/4 Engineering Certificate with 7 subjects and relevant trade theory included.

In addition to the above minimum requirements candidates must also meet the following requirements:

- Technical knowledge.
- Must be able to work in a team.
- Appointments to these positions are dependent on successful completion of screening protocols, such as being declared medically fit, security clearance, qualification verifications, and technical assessments.
